CCW Instructors,

To be in compliance with Senate Bill AB 2103, the following is the Yuba County Sheriff's Departments course of fire requirements for all CCW applicants:

- 15 Yards 10 Rounds
- 7 Yards 5 rounds
- 3 Yards 5 Rounds strong hand only
- 3 Yards 5 Rounds supported

All rounds must be on target, 80% of rounds inside silhouette is passing

- A Standard B27 target will be used for the qualification.
- A total of 25 rounds per firearm.
- Each firearm to be carried under the permit must be used to pass the course of fire.

The above course of fire is pursuant to California Penal Code Section 26165(b), a licensing authority shall establish, and make available to the public, the standards it uses when issuing licenses with regards to the required live-fire shooting exercises, including, but not limited to, a minimum number of rounds to be fired and minimum passing scores from specified firing distances.

To remain on our CCW approved firearms instructor list, you shall adjust your course of fire to match our requirements. If you should have any questions, please contact our CCW Coordinator CSO Rosa Leon at (530)749-7777.
